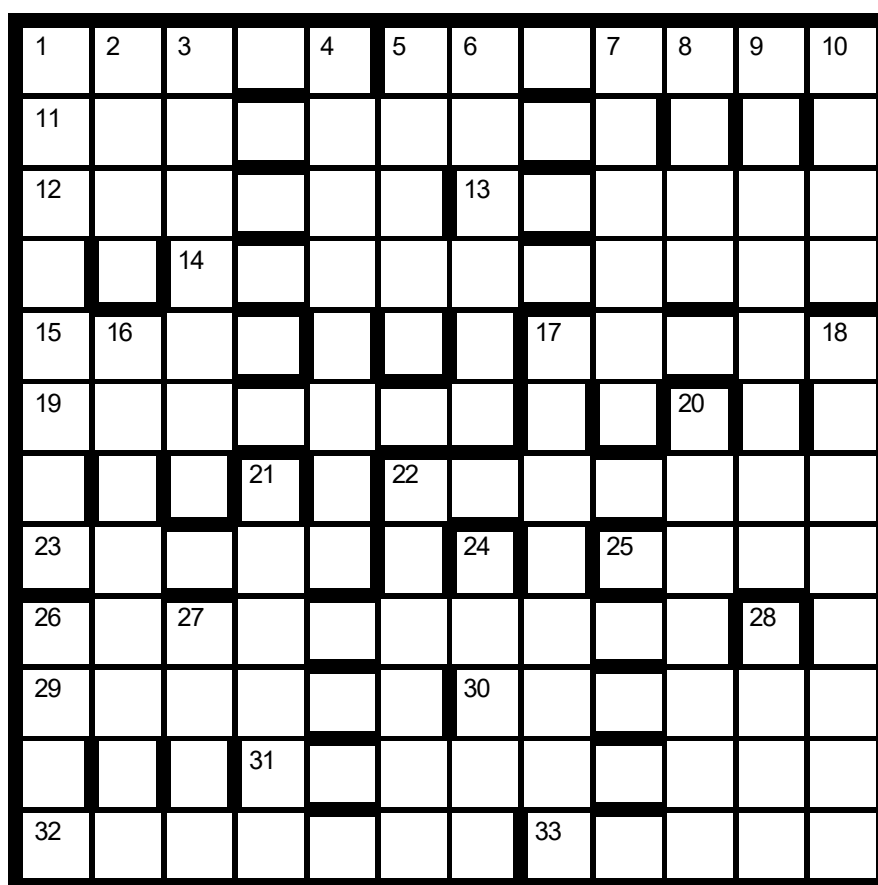


'Once the Penny Drops'

Across clues lead to words which are to be treated in a uniform way (related to the theme of the puzzle) before entry in the diagram. Definitions in these clues refer to the answers before treatment: subsidiary indications (anagrams, etc.) refer to the answers as they appear in the diagram. The numbers in brackets after each clue indicate the length of the answers before treatment. Down clues have been treated in *precisely the opposite way* to that referred to above. Solvers must first 'untreat' them before attempting to solve them. In addition one letter only in each down word (never an unchecked one) appears misprinted in the diagram. The original letters which these misprints replace (not the misprints themselves) spell out, when taken in clue order, an explanatory and thematic quotation (in the *Oxford Dictionary of Quotations*).

Solvers must submit a cryptic clue to replace the asterisked definition of the same general form as the other down answers, ensuring that they fully satisfy the requirements above [I don't have the original version of this paragraph so have tried to recreate it].
